

# Temporary Holding Protocol

Temporary Holding Protocols start with the letter “H”

These were created so clients can view their census, invoices, and perform allocations.

Uses Include:

- When a protocol expires and there are active cage cards on census
- When animals need to be weaned and not enough animals remain on a protocol
- For incoming animals when a protocol is pending approval for a new submission or amendment. This requires LAR approval
- Extenuating circumstances as determined by LAR and IACUC staff

The holding protocol fee will be charged per billing cycle while the animals remain on a temporary holding protocol. Unless otherwise requested, the fee will be charged to the holding protocol and account listed under the active cage cards.
