

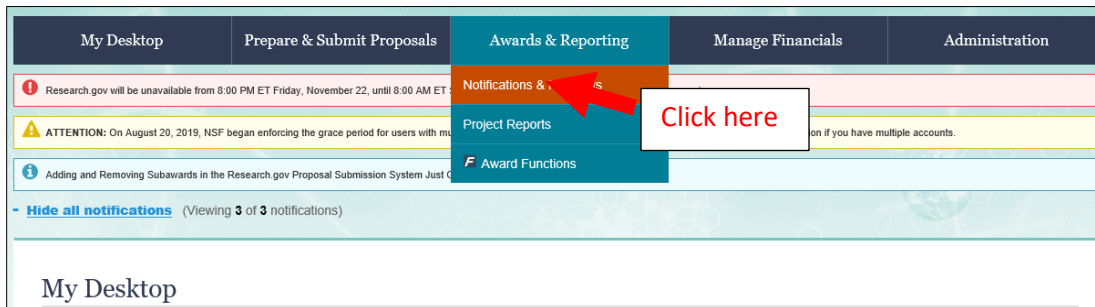
NSF No-Cost Extension in Research.gov

PIs have to initiate a request for a no-cost extension using the Research.gov award portal. You will need to know your NSF ID and password, as well as the 7-digit NSF award number.

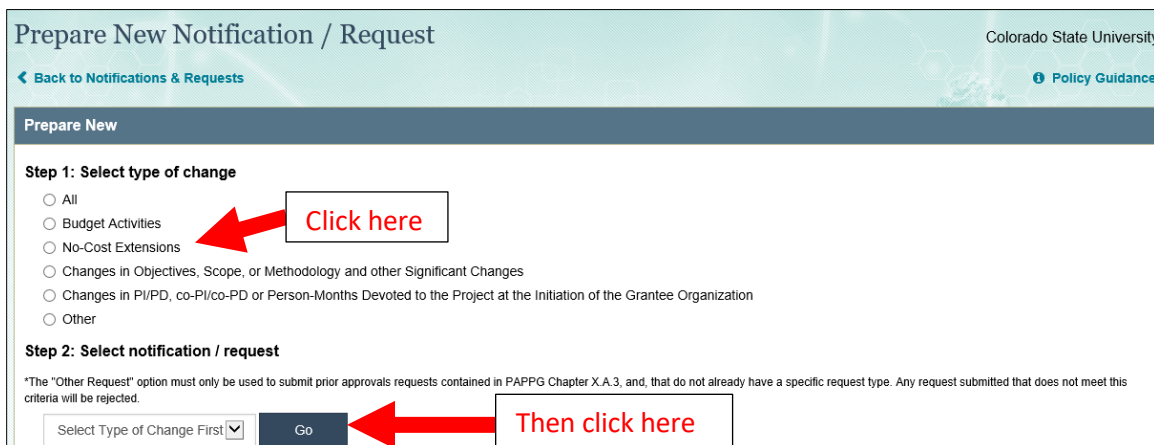
- Log in to [research.gov](https://www.research.gov) with your ID and password information
- Click on the Awards & Reporting link at the top of the page, and then select Notifications & Requests from the dropdown:



- Click “Prepare New”



- On the Prepare New Notification/Request page, for Step 1, choose “No-Cost Extensions”
- The box in Step 2 will populate “No-Cost Extension”. Click the “Go” button
- For Step 3, enter the 7-digit NSF award number (not the CSU account number)
- Click “Prepare New”



Step 2: Select notification / request

*The "Other Request" option must only be used to submit prior approvals requests contained in PAPPG Chapter X.A.3, and, that do not already have a specific request type. Any request submitted that does not meet this criteria will be rejected.

No-Cost Extension

Step 3: Enter award number and click 'Prepare New'.

Award Number: Enter NSF award # here

Then click here

Grantee-Approved No-Cost Extension:

A first no-cost extension on an NSF award is a 'Grantee-Approved' NCE.

In the Research.gov website form:

Enter the new end date (up to 12 months from the current end date) and a brief justification.

Click the Save & Submit button. This will send the request to Sponsored Programs for approval and submission to NSF.

A Grantee-Approved No-Cost Extension is automatically approved, and NSF will NOT issue an amendment to the award showing the new end date. OSP will use the submission confirmation email to update Quali so that the new end date will appear on the sponsored project account.

NSF-Approved No-Cost Extension

If you are requesting a second extension, it will be an NSF-Approved No-Cost Extension. More information is required, and approval is not automatic.

- A 2nd NCE request has to be submitted no later than 45 days prior to the current end date.
- PIs will need to work with their department research administrator or KFS account Fiscal Officer to determine the amount of funds that would be unobligated as of the current end date.

In the Research.gov website form:

Enter the new requested end date, the amount of remaining funds in the grant, the justification for the NSF-Approved No-Cost Extension, and the plan for the use of the unobligated funds.

Click the "Save & Submit" button. This will send the request to Sponsored Programs for approval and submission to NSF.

When OSP receives the amendment, information in Kualu will be updated to extend the project and budget end dates for the project account.
