



PHS Financial Conflict of Interest (FCOI) Training Requirements

All investigators participating in the design, conduct, or reporting of research sponsored by one of the federal Public Health Service (PHS) agencies, or by other organizations that have adopted the PHS Financial Conflict of Interest (FCOI) regulations, must complete PHS FCOI training. The training must be completed prior to engaging in funded research and should be renewed at least every four (4) years.

CSU investigators with incomplete or out-of-date PHS FCOI training are required to complete the PHS FCOI training tutorial found on the CSU Research Integrity & Compliance Review Office (RICRO) website.
