OSP – Value Added

The Award review provided by the OSP adds value by:

- Acting as Authorized Representatives throughout lifecycle
- Distributing finalized documents to campus stakeholders



Common Account Types

- 53 = Sponsored Programs
- 88/89 = Work in Progress (WIP)
- 21 = internal service
- 22 = external recharge
- 64 = Gift funds
 - Not managed by OSP

Cost Reimbursable

- Recipient reimbursed by sponsor for costs incurred on agreement
- Scope and budget typically flexible
- **Do not exceed Cost ceiling**, recipient responsible for excess costs
- Costs **reportable and auditable**
- When period of performance and reporting are complete, remaining funds **returned to sponsor**

Fixed Price Payment

- **Fixed amount** regardless of how much the scope costs
- Scope and budget are well defined
- Money only returned if the Termination condition identifies a specific situation occurred
- When scope is complete:
 - If funds remain, the recipient retains funds
 - If costs exceed funding, the recipient incurs the excess costs
