Welcome to SPIN, the Sponsored Programs Information Network

SPIN is a searchable funding opportunity database that provides detailed, up-to-date information about thousands of Federal, non-Federal, and International programs in support of research, travel, curriculum development, collaborative projects, sabbatical support, fellowship opportunities, publication support and more.

ACCESSING SPIN

- Go to www.infoedglobal.com. This will take you to the SPIN page supported and maintained by InfoEd International.
- Select SPIN in the top, horizontal menu.
NOTE: SPIN is restricted to CSU employees and students so you must be on campus, or using the VPN, to access.
- Once on the SPIN site, you will need to Log In. If you are a first time user, you will need to create a new profile using a Username of your choice and your CSU email.
- After logging in, you can run a Text (basic) or Advanced Search. There is a Help dropdown that provides additional information along with helpful Training Videos. The videos will walk you through how to conduct an Advanced Search, how to save a search, and how to save criteria for later use.

KEY SPIN FEATURES

Text Search: Most widely used basic search. Search using words that identify your criteria. For example, "Psychology" or "Experimental Psychology." See "Help/Text Search" for additional information.

Keyword Search: Search by selecting Keywords available in the system. See "Help/Keyword Search" for additional information.

Advanced Search: Perform sophisticated searches using filters such as application location, applicant type, project type, project location, sponsor type, and more. See "Help/Advanced Search" for additional information.

Save Searches: Save your search criteria or view other saved searches made available to the SPIN community. See "Help/Training Videos" for saving and managing saved searches.

Funding Alerts: Receive automatic e-mail notifications daily or weekly when programs match your saved search criteria. See "Help/Training Videos" for managing funding alerts.

Export Data Options: Under "Preferences," export search results to a Word or Excel document.

Email: Send search results via e-mail to self or colleague.
