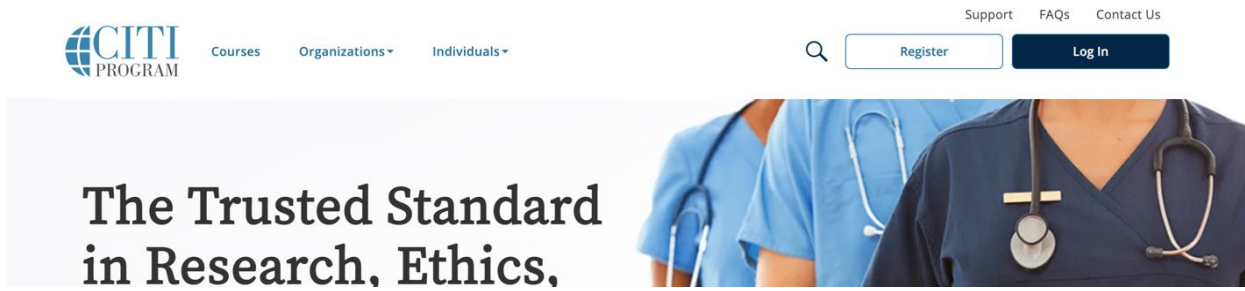

SSO requires a username and password issued by the organization.


Click on the organization name for SSO login instructions.
